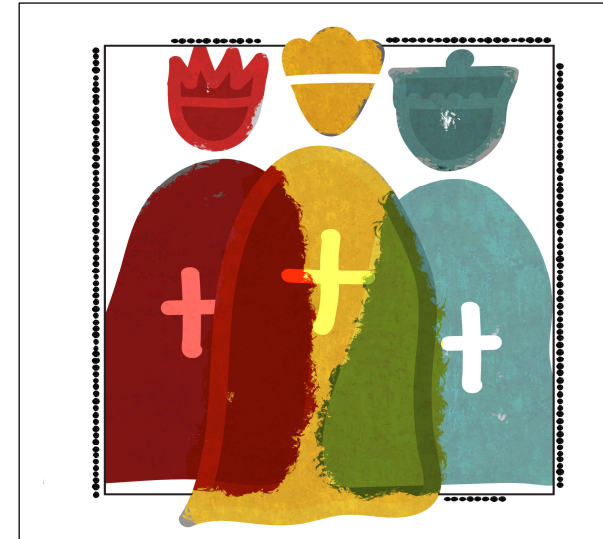

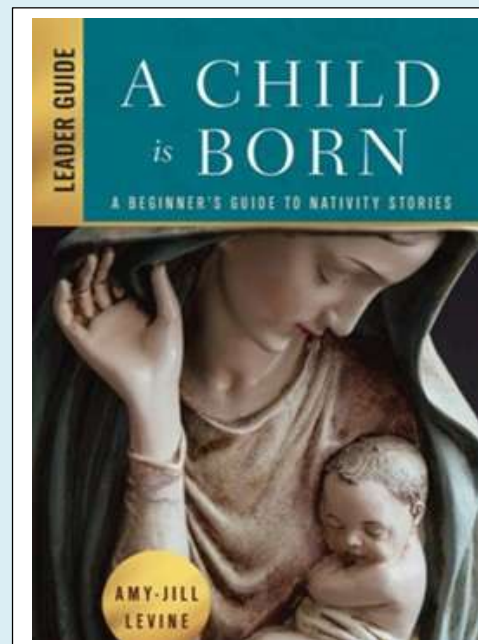

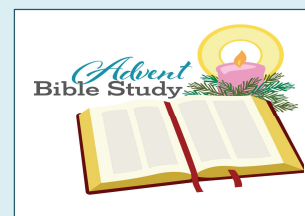
Rev. Doyle will be leading an Advent Bible Study,

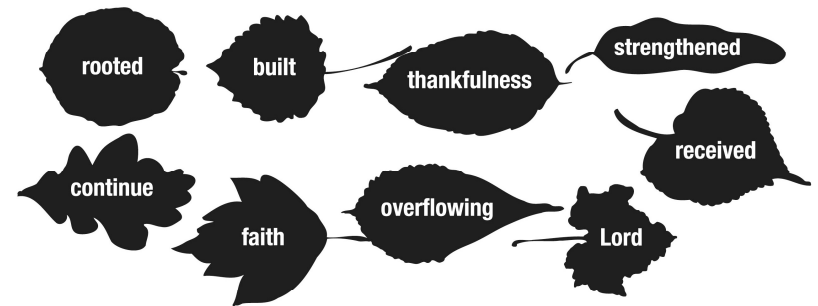
