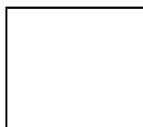

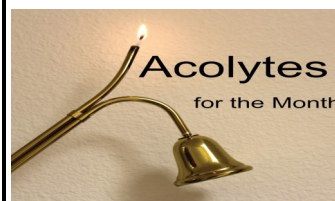

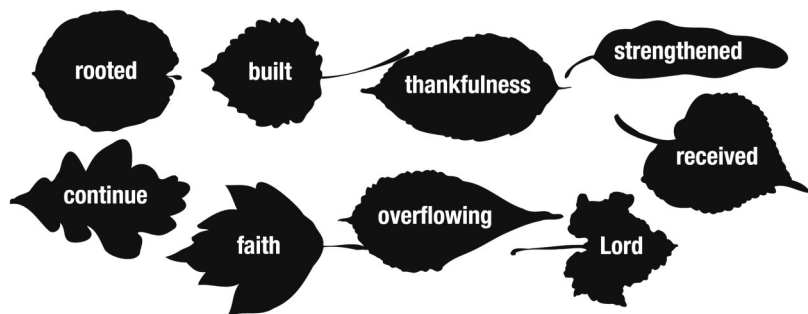




# Piles of praise

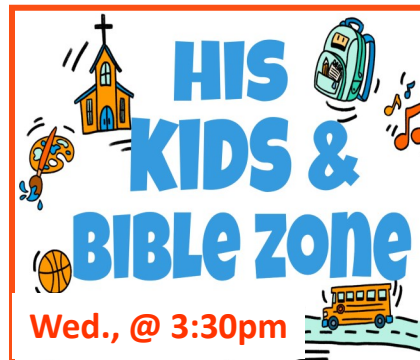
## Christmas Food Box Sign-Ups

**Monday, November 25th from 5pm - 7pm.**

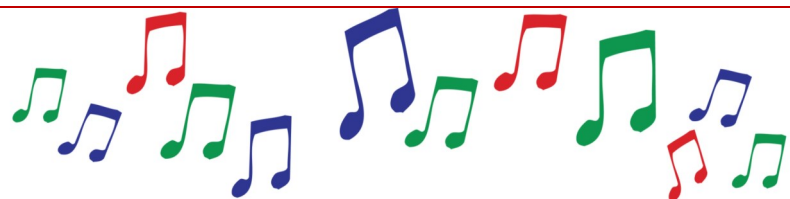
Those who are age 55 years and

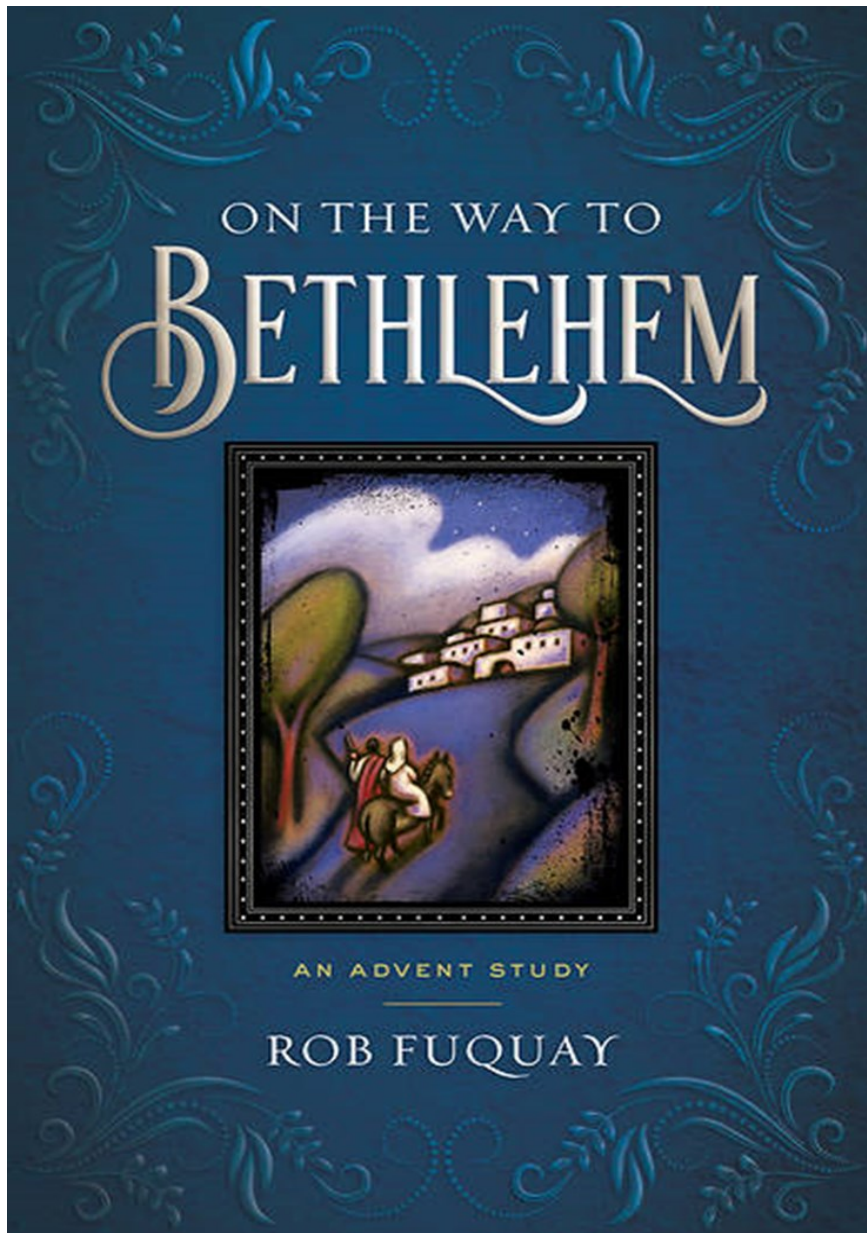
## Free Music Reading Class

*On the Way to Bethlehem* follows the long journey to Christmas. Chapters include:
